**LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION – ACADEMIC (OPTIONAL):** One academic letter of recommendation is optional. It is strongly recommended that this letter be written by a faculty member in the applicant’s academic major.

**LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION – EMPLOYMENT (OPTIONAL):** One letter of recommendation from a current or previous employer is optional. If selecting a previous employer, it must be an employer you worked for in the last 5 years. It is strongly recommended that this letter be written by your current employer if you are currently employed.

**OTHER REQUIREMENTS: Applicant must be a resident of Los Angeles County.** A minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA is required. Scholarship awards will be determined based upon the applicants’ career interests, grade point average, dedication to the profession of land surveying, land surveying organization affiliation, and geographic location. These criteria are inclusive and not necessarily listed in order of selection importance.

**TRANSCRIPTS:** Please attach a copy of official academic transcripts through spring or fall semester of the year in which the scholarship application is submitted for review by the Award Committee.
