History of Boundary Surveys in the City of Los Angeles

Robert Nielsen, PLS heads the City of Los Angeles, Public Works Department, Survey Division as the Engineer of Surveys. He will discuss the history of land division in the City of Los Angeles, including survey monumentation and perpetuation of the original subdivision block corners.

He'll provide the background on the measurements obtained by the City of Los Angeles, Survey Division which determined the best-fit street centerlines and the timeline for such work. Included will be a description of the establishment and densification of the monument network that provides geodetic values to the existing centerline monumentation. Robert will discuss the integration of the geodetic and centerline intersection networks in the City of Los Angeles. The information provided is a "must have" for surveyors who perform boundary surveys and those preparing for licensure examinations.

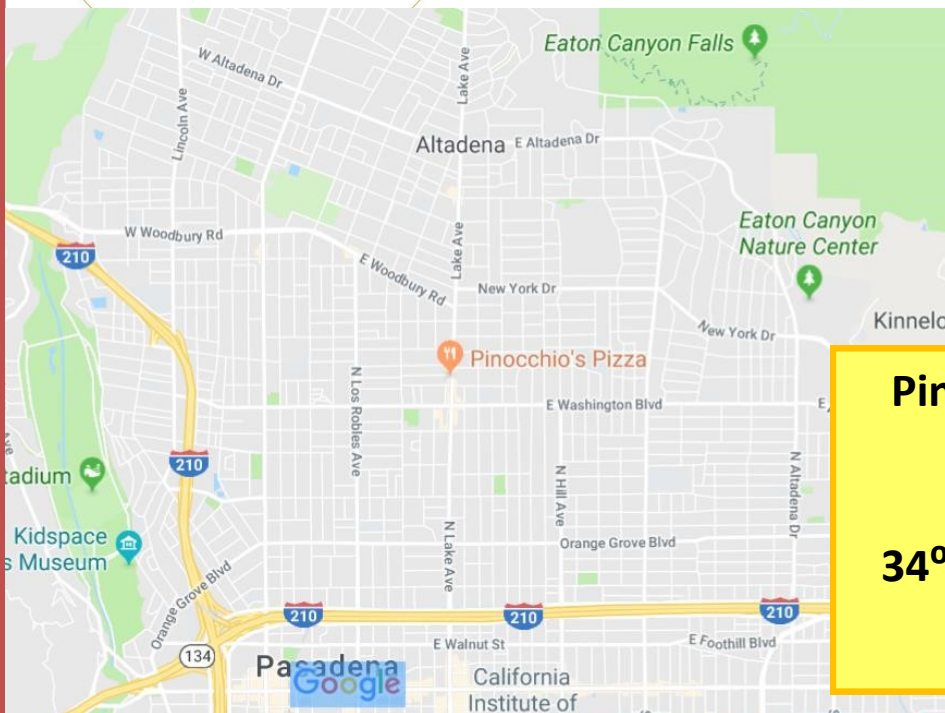
